

Items to be Transferred from Elmbridge Museum's Collection

The items going to Guildford Museum for education purposes are as follows:

67.1969/1: Five medieval oyster shells excavated from Newark Priory

67.1969/3: Medieval roofing tile with hole for peg, possibly from Newark Priory

The following item is being transferred to Woodbridge Museum:

L.302.1967: Palaeolithic hand axe. Ferruginous and ochreous stained flint in a very crude form. May be early Acheulian. Cortex on butt end. Rubbed and battered. Length of 1220mm and width of 838mm. Possibly from Woodbridge/Suffolk. Leant by Duncan Hislop in 1967 who has given permission for the item to be given to another museum.

All of these items are not from the Borough of Elmbridge and are therefore not relevant to our collection.
