

Itemised List of Individual Objects from the Broadwood Trust Collection

The following items are being transferred to Dorking Museum because the original owner of the costume, EHT Broadwood from Lyne, helped to set up Dorking Museum. The collection is not relevant to Elmbridge Borough.

- 1) L.11.1978/1: Broadwood Trust 19th century men's waistcoat in cream silk with woven floral design in mauves and brown with a shawl collar. Thought to date from circa 1850. Front 54cm long
- 2) L.11.1978/2: Broadwood Trust men's evening dress shirt with stiff front and single cuffs, labelled 'Hawkins & Co., Piccadilly, W'. Contains name tape with 'E.H.T.Broadwood' inscribed. Shirt 98 cms long.
- 3) L.11.1978/3: Broadwood Trust men's tunic style, white collarless shirt in white cotton with widely spaced blue stripe. Single cuffs with link holes. 'W. Hayford & Sons, Sloane St., S. W.' Marked 'E.H.T Broadwood'. Shirt 96cms long.
- 4) L.11.1978/4: Broadwood Trust men's tunic style collarless cream cotton shirt. Double cuffs with link holes and the shirt buttons with 3 pearl buttons. Labelled 'James Drew, Burlington Arcade' and marked 'E.H.T.B'. Shirt 94cm long.
- 5) L.11.1978/5: Broadwood Trust 20th century men's black worsted waistcoat with 4 slit pockets, 6 black bone buttons. Black sateen back with adjustable strap. Waistcoat lined with cream cotton with red/blue stripes. Waistcoat 50 cms in length. Circa 1930s.
- 6) L.11.1978/6: Broadwood Trust 20th century men's white evening dress waistcoat, marcella weave. 2 slit pockets and 3 self-covered buttons. Waistcoat has a white cotton back with adjustable strap. Waistcoat 51cms in length. Circa 1930.
- 7) L.11.1978/7: Broadwood Trust 20th century men's white pique evening dress waistcoat with white cotton back and adjustable strap. Length 47cms. Circa 1930.
- 8) L.11.1978/8: Broadwood Trust men's 20th century white pique evening dress waistcoat with white cotton back and adjustable strap. Length of 47cms. Circa 1930s.
- 9) L.11.1978/9: Broadwood Trust men's white pique evening dress waistcoat with white cotton back and adjustable dress. 47cms long. Circa 1930s.
- 10) L.11.1978/10: Broadwood Trust men's flannel trousers with pointed waist at back. 6 cream bone buttons to take braces and 3 slots to take a belt. Adjustable straps at sides and turn-ups. Labelled 'Robinson & Cleaver, London, W'. Trousers worn by a member of the family when playing cricket in village matches. Length 105cms. C.1930-39. (Some moth damage)

- 40) L.11.1978/40: Broadwood Trust men's pair of black silk evening socks. Length of foot 26 cms and leg 33 cms.
- 41) L.11.1978/41: Broadwood Trust men's pair of cream kid gloves which fasten with 1 pearl button. Length 27cms.
- 42) L.11.1978/42: Broadwood Trust men's black crepe mourning arm band, lined with black cotton. Length 39cm, width 110 cms.
- 43) L.11.1978/43: Broadwood Trust men's pyjama jacket in cream flannel, with narrow pink stripe. Coat style, with collar. Fastens with 4 pearl buttons and has a patch pocket. Length 77 cms.
- 44) L.11.1978/44: Broadwood Trust linen hemstitched handkerchief. Size: 48cms squared.
- 45) L.12.1978/1: Broadwood Trust open robe of brown silk taffeta with low square neck and bodice fastening in front with tapes. Elbow length tight sleeves and bodice lined with cream cotton with 2 bones at back. Skirt gathered on to back of bodice. Length of149cms.
- 46) L.12.1978/2: Broadwood Trust women's printed silk shawl in brown and cream floral design with a red background. Dimensions: 95 x 85 cms.
- 47) L.12.1978/3: Broadwood Trust nineteenth century women's cap in white spotted muslin. Muslin curtain edged with lace and front edged with lace frill with 2 more lace frills over crown. Band of lace insertion towards back of cap and cotton ties. C.1840.
- 48) L.12.1978/4: Broadwood Trust women's night cap in white cotton with band of tucks and eyelet embroidery around front. Also 2 lace edged frills around front and cotton ties. C.1840.
- 49) L.12.1978/5: Broadwood Trust women's night cap of white cotton. Bands of eyelet embroidery and gathered insertion around front. Also two lace frills around front and cotton ties. C.1840.
- 50) L.12.1978/6: Broadwood Trust women's night cap of white cotton with bands of eyelet embroidery and gathered insertions. Muslin frill has mostly rotted away. Cotton ties. C.1840.
- 51) L.12.1978/7: Broadwood Trust women's night cap of white cotton with bands of eyelet embroidery and gathered insertion going across. 2 lace edged frills and cotton ties. C.1840.

- 52) L.12.1978/8: Broadwood Trust pair of women's cream silk stockings. Not quite a pair although very similar. One marked '1 R.H.' in blue cross stitch, one marked 'R.Harris' in ink. Length of foot a)24cms b)25cms. Length of leg a)67cms b)65cms.
- 53) L.12.1978/9: Broadwood Trust pair of women's navy blue silk stockings with white lisle toes and tops. Length of foot 23cms. Length of leg 60cms. Length of navy blue part of leg 32cms.
- 54) L.12.1978/10: Broadwood Trust women's one white cotton stocking marked 'A.J.M.' Length of foot 24 cm Length of leg 63 cm.
- 55) L.12.1978/11: Broadwood Trust deep collar in white organdie, edged with narrow white lace. Length of 85cms, depth: 26cms.
- 56) L.12.1978/12: Broadwood Trust habit shirt type collar in cream net, with frill at neck. Max. depth at front: 30cms.
- 57) L.12.1978/13: Broadwood Trust tape lace collar, white. Length of 80cms, max depth at point 25cms.
- 58) L.12.1978/14: Broadwood Trust tape lace collar, white. Length: 80cms, max depth at point 20cms.
- 59) L.12.1978/15: Broadwood Trust tape lace collar, white. Length of 80cms, max depth at point, 17cms.
- 60) L.12.1978/16: Broadwood Trust women's purse in embroidered canvas; royal blue and gold. Blue cord handles with 2 gilt binds. Dimensions: 13.5 x 11.5cms.
- 61) L.12.1978/17: Broadwood Trust twentieth century women's purse embroidered in petit point in bands of light and dark fawn and pink, with a multi coloured floral design. Purse bound in blue and gold cord with 2 tassels and brown cord handle. Small gilt fastener in centre. Dimensions: 21.5 x 15cms.
- 62) L.12.1978/18: Broadwood Trust women's long purse netted in mid-green and bright pink. Gilt knob each end, and 1 gilt band with pink and green design. Length 20 cms. [without knobs].
- 63) L.12.1978/19: Broadwood Trust women's long purse netted in sage green cotton with silver bead tassel each end. Length 16cms. [without tassels].
- 64) L.12.1978/20: Broadwood Trust women's long purse netted in brown cotton with silver beads and 2 silver bead tassels. Length 26cms [without tassels].
- 65) L.12.1978/21: Broadwood Trust women's knitted purse in scallops of white, yellow and green. Drawstring top, with cord in yellow and green with tassels. Dimensions: 21cms. x 11cms.
- 66) L.12.1978/22: Broadwood Trust women's long purse netted in green and purple silk with gilt knobs each end. Length 18cms [without knobs].
- 67) L.13.1978/1: Broadwood Trust baby's cap in cream net with hem stitched insertion.
- 68) L.13.1978/2: Broadwood Trust baby's cap in white muslin with Ayrshire work and lace frill around.
- 69) L.13.1978/3: Broadwood Trust baby's cap in white cotton in bands of hemstitching, tucks and embroidery.
- 70) L.14.1978/1: Broadwood Trust round wooden box with push-on domed lid containing white swan's down powder puff. Box diameter: 7.5cms. Height: 7.5cms
- 71) L.14.1978/2: Broadwood Trust white swan's down powder puff, green satin back and ivory knob. This is believed to be the puff inside L14.1978/1.
- 72) L.14.1978/3: Broadwood Trust necklace of brown hair, plaited, interspersed with four gilt bands. Length 60cms.
- 73) L.14.1978/4: Broadwood Trust diamante dress clip, multi coloured on gilt. Length 65cms.
- 74) L.14.1978/5: Broadwood Trust rectangular buckle with geometrical design in black embossed on gilt. Dimensions of 85cms x 4cms.
- 75) L.14.1978/6: Broadwood Trust shoe horn in cream bone, with brown ribbon threaded through handle. Length 15cms.
- 76) L.14.1978/7: Broadwood Trust five small brown tortoiseshell hair combs. a) 5 x 3.5cm, b) 4.7 x 2.7 cm, c) 4 x 4 cm, d) 3.5 x 3.5 cm, e) 2 x 4.5 cm

77) L.15.1978/16: Broadwood Trust thirteen buttons, covered with black velvet in various sizes in cardboard box covered with green paper with gold motif and edging. Box: 13.5 x 9 x 3.25cm.

- 6) L.15.1978/6: Length of plain cream insertion on card.
- 7) L.15.1978/7: Collection of thirteen different coloured silks, on cards.
- 8) L.15.1978/8: Cotton reel, with silk in variegated black and red.
- 9) L.15.1978/9: Four spools of silk - different colours.
- 10) L.15.1978/10: Four bone and two steel needles
- 11) L.15.1978/11: Piece of fine cream netting, like a long purse, but no slit. Gathered with cream ribbon at one end, other end is open. Packet containing "Nitting (sic) by Mrs Bisbee, Rickford, aged 90" dated October 8th 1859.
- 12) L.15.1978/12: Length of cream lace on blue card.
- 13) L.15.1978/13: Three steel purse rings.
- 14) L.15.1978/14: Bag of miscellaneous scraps of lace and material.
- 15) L.15.1978/15: Kettle holder embroidered in petit point in red and green wool, backed with red silk, with hanging loop. Dimensions of 9 x 9.5cm. Contained in basket L.15.1978/1
