We send herewith the blue print required and actually this body is 8" wider than the model demonstrated to you. The price of this vehicle without any interior equipment would be £345. and the price of the model as demonstrated without interior equipment and excluding locker is £335. The price of model "D" Shell with Model "B" equipment is £355.






